







## Resolution no. 124/2018 adopted by the Senate of Wroclaw University of Environmental and Life Sciences on the $19^{\rm th}$ of December 2018

concerning the detailed rules of admitting laureates and finalists of the central level contests, winners of international and national competitions which took place in the following years 2019/2020, 2020/2021, 2021/2022 i 2022/2023

Based on the Art. 70 par. 6 point 1 and 2 of the Act issued on the 20<sup>th</sup> of July 2018 Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws 2018, item 1668) in accordance with the Art. 227 par. 3 and the Art. 266 par. 2 of the Act issued on the 3<sup>rd</sup> of July 2018 Introducing the Act - Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2018, item 1669) and §7 par. 2 point 2 of the Statute of the Wroclaw University of Environmental and Life Sciences, Senate of the Wroclaw University of Environmental and Life Sciences determines the rules for admitting laureates and finalists of the central level competitions, winners of international and national competitions which took place in the following years 2019/2020, 2020/2021, 2021/2022 and 2022/2023:

§1

Central level contest the laureates and finalists of which are admitted to the Wroclaw University of Environmental and Life Sciences without qualifying the procedure are listed in the attachment to this resolution constituting its integral part.

§2

A document issued by the main organizing committee of a given contest bearing an order number stating the place taken by a particular candidate for studies in the central qualifying rounds serves as the grounds for obtaining the rights listed in the resolution.

§3

The rights indicated in § 1 can be used by laureates and finalists twice - during the year of obtaining the secondary school-leaving certificate and in the year following the award of the title of laureate or finalist of the central level contest.

§4

The finalists and winners of the contests who have sufficient grades granted for the subjects covered by the qualification procedure will be accepted without the need of participating in qualification procedure.

§5

1. When it comes to the academic years 2019/2020 and 2020/2021, the winners and finalists of the first five places of the Central Degree Biology and Chemistry Contest are to be admitted









to full-time studies in the field of veterinary medicine without the need to participate in the qualification procedure.

- 2. When it comes to the academic years 2019/2020 and 2020/2021, the laureates of the central level of the Contest concerning Agricultural Knowledge and Skills the thematic block of veterinary medicine are to be admitted to the field of veterinary medicine without the need to participate in qualification procedure.
- 3. The number of winners and finalists of all contest cannot exceed 5% of the admission limit for studies in the field of veterinary medicine in the academic years 2019/2020 and 2020/2021.
- 4. When it comes to the academic years 2021/2022 and 2022/2023, full-time studies in the field of veterinary medicine in Polish and English, the winners and finalists of the first five places of the central degree of the national Biology and Chemistry Contest and the international Biology and Chemistry contest are to be admitted without the need of participating in qualification procedure. Moreover, the candidates for studies in English must additionally meet the recruitment conditions regarding knowledge of English, specified in the recruitment rules.
- 5. When it comes to the academic years 2021/2022 and 2022/2023 for the field of veterinary medicine in Polish and English, the winners of the first three places of the central level of the Contest concerning Agricultural Knowledge and Skills the thematic block of veterinary medicine are to be admitted without the need to participate in qualification procedure provided that they have passed matriculation examination in biology and chemistry at a minimum level of 30% in each of these subjects. What is more, candidates for studies in English must meet the recruitment conditions regarding the knowledge of English, specified in the recruitment rules.

§6

The winners and finalists of the first ten places of the central level contests are to be admitted to the Faculty of Environmental Engineering and Geodesy and the Faculty of Biotechnology and Food Sciences without the need to participate in qualification procedure in accordance with the attachment to this resolution.

§7

Resolution No. 34/2017 of the Senate of the Wroclaw University of Environmental and Life Sciences adopted on the 28<sup>th</sup> of April 2017 on the detailed rules for admitting laureates and finalists of the central level contests in 2018/2019, 2019/2020, 2020/2021 is repealed.

§8

The resolution becomes effective on the day of its adoption.
