Method of converting grades based on certificates obtained abroad entitling to undertake BA/BSc studies and MA/MSc studies

The number of points (LP) for candidates with a certificate obtained abroad is converted according to the following formula:

LP = WJo + WJoj + (WPw x 10) – applicable to all majors (apart from veterinary medicine studies),

W - refers to the result awarded on the foreign certificate converted into a recruitment point expressed as a percentage (table 1)

WJo – refers to the number of percentage points concerning a foreign language;

WJoj – refers to the number of percentage points concerning the mother tongue;

WPw – refers to a higher number of points for the recruitment subject indicated in the resolution

calculated based on the following rule:

0,4 x WP or 1,0 x WR,

WP – percentage points obtained at the standard level;

WR – percentage points obtained at the high level;

In case of veterinary medicine studies:

LP= WR(B)+ WR(Ch)

WR(B)- refers to an advanced biology result

WR(Ch)- refers to an advanced chemistry result
