

## **Regulation No. 90/2021 issued by the Rector of the Wrocław University of Environmental and Life Sciences on the 29<sup>th</sup> of April 2021**

on determining the amount of fees for educational services provided at the Wrocław University of Environmental and Life Sciences for study cycles starting in the academic year 2021/2022

Based on the Art. 79 par. 1, the Art. 80 par. 2 of the Act issued on the 20<sup>th</sup> of July 2018 - Law on Higher Education and Science (Journal of Laws of 2021, item 478, as amended) and pursuant to § 8 par. 3 point 2 of the Statute of the Wrocław University of Environmental and Life Sciences, constituting an attachment to Resolution No. 56/2019 adopted by the Senate of the Wrocław University of Environmental and Life Sciences on the 28<sup>th</sup> of June 2019 on the adoption of the Statute of the Wrocław University of Environmental and Life Sciences, as well as § 2.1 of the Regulation No. 89/2021 issued by the Rector of the Wrocław University of Environmental and Life Sciences on the 29<sup>th</sup> of April 2021 on the rules of charging fees for the provided educational services from full-time and part-time students of BA/BMs, MA/MSc and long-cycle master's studies as well as the procedure and conditions for exemption from the aforementioned fees, it was established as follows:

### § 1

The amount of fees for educational services at full-time studies conducted in Polish for Polish citizens and foreigners, referred to in the Art. 324 par. 2, of the Act issued on the 20<sup>th</sup> of July 2018 - Law on Higher Education and Science covers:

- 1) for repeating a subject due to unsatisfactory learning results - PLN 8 for each hour of classes (lectures and classes);
- 2) for each hour of classes not covered by the study programme - PLN 8.

### § 2

1. The amount of tuition fees for foreigners obliged to pay fees for full-time studies conducted in Polish is:

1. A fee of PLN 8 is collected for repeating a subject due to unsatisfactory learning results for each hour of classes (lectures and classes). The fee for repeating classes from one semester in part-time studies cannot exceed the fee for this semester.
2. For each hour of classes not covered by the curriculum, the student shall pay a fee of PLN 8.

### § 3

1. The amount of fees for the education of Polish citizens and foreigners at studies conducted in a foreign language is as follows:

3. A fee of PLN 10 is collected for repeating a subject due to unsatisfactory learning results for each hour of classes (lectures and tutorials). The fee for repeating classes from one semester in part-time studies cannot exceed the fee for this semester.
4. For each hour of classes not covered by the curriculum, the student shall pay a fee of PLN 10.

### § 4

\*) – the fee is paid only by students admitted beyond the limit set by the bilateral agreement between the units conducting joint studies

1. For repeating a subject due to unsatisfactory learning results, a fee of PLN 20 is collected for each hour of classes (lectures and classes), except for the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, where the fee is PLN 50. The fee for repeating classes from one semester in studies conducted in a foreign language may not exceed the fee for this semester.
2. For each hour of classes not covered by the study program, the student shall pay a fee of PLN 20, except for the Faculty of Veterinary Medicine, where the fee is PLN 50.

## § 5

A student taking some classes in a particular semester pays the fee referred to in § 2, 3 and 4 par. 1, in proportion to the number of realized ECTS points in relation to the full number of ECTS points provided for in the study programme for this semester.

## § 6

The regulation comes into force on the day of signing with effect from the 1st of October 2021
